Receiving teachings in an environment of retreat can bring about a profound transformation in our being and open the possibility of looking at ourselves, our lives and the world around us with a fresh perspective. Each day will include zazen, chanting, private interviews and dharma talks. The study text will be taken from the Flower Adornment Sutra, Chapter 36, Universal Worthy's Conduct. Particular attention will be given to anger as a causal condition which gives rise to a number of obstructions to walking the Bodhisattva's path.
